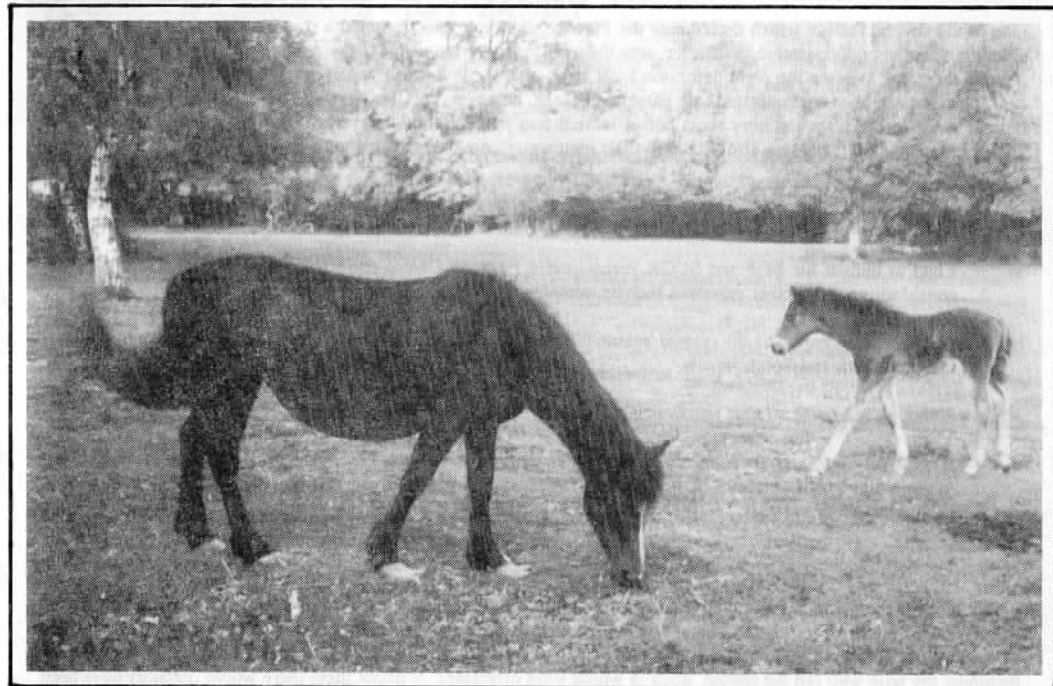

ORGANISER'S COMMENTS - BILL MANSELL

On the day before the event it was sunny and warm and every-thing looked lovely. The autumn colours over the top of the forest were spectacular. The site preparation had gone well, which was a pleasure to supervise. Disappointment with the dull drizzle on the day of the event changed to relief, with the driving rain and gales of the following day, that it wasn't any worse.

One of the several factors which determined the Planner's and my selection of the site, besides its compactness, its situation and a very cooperative landowner, was the availability of tap water at the refreshment point. Great was my chagrin therefore to learn the night before on local radio and TV that piped water from the river Test serving areas near the event had been contaminated by a parasite. Thanks, however, to Allan Farrington of UNICON an army water bowser came to the rescue at very short notice (which also inadvertently delayed the car parking for a while - my apologies). Some SOC helpers also provided their own water containers; filled with non-test water.

To those who, perhaps understandably, rankled at the high entrance fee, and a car parking fee on top, I would say that:

- I had to budget for BOF and SCOA levies, and a Forestry Commission fee, totalling over £3,700; before considering all the other expenses such as mapping and printing costs and prizes.
- A car parking fee of £1.00 seemed reasonable bearing in mind that it costs £1.00 to park for just one hour in Portsmouth and Southampton.
- Although not perfect (what site ever is?), in many ways it was about as good a site as one could ever find.
- After a very thorough reconnaissance of the area by the Planner and myself the only practical alternative was to use a number of car parks in the Lyndhurst area some 5-8 miles away and bus; with all the possible traffic problems and dislocation.
- We still had the highest number of entrants ever at a November Classic.

I apologise for the delay in putting up the results: a consequence of under manning and not giving sufficient priority to it. With hindsight I can see that I should either have cut back on non-essential tasks, such as the creche, or sought help from other local clubs such as SUOC. As it was, I was fortunate to have the help of my family and their friends, including my wife who ran the creche, none of whom were orienteers. Without them there would certainly have been no creche and there would have been under manning for the later period in the car park.

I will express my thanks separately to my own club members who helped. I thank particularly Ray Massey, the Planner, and David Lee, the Controller, for their support and cooperation on which I could always rely; Mrs Anne Cooper, her husband and father for providing every reasonable assistance right through the planning stage and up to the event itself; the Hythe Scouts for lending their large tent and furniture; St John Ambulance, who had a busy day; and to Mark Matthews for lending his most impressive starting clock apparatus. The London Orienteering Klok, which can display hours, minutes and seconds for marathon type events, can be hired from Matthew on 081-543-2179.

To the runner who got himself disqualified for insisting on running without a whistle I would say: 'if you can't accept the rules you should not have taken part'.

PLANNER'S COMMENTS - RAY MASSEY

Well, that all went off rather well I think. True I did hear a few niggles (mainly from M21Es about control 344); but in an event of this size (2 maps, 24 courses, 56 classes, 125 controls, there are always likely to be a few things wrong. (Interestingly you did not complain about those items I was most worried about - no, my lips are sealed.)

Most people seemed to enjoy their gloomy excursion around Acres Down. If only we'd had the event on the previous day, then you would have seen the forest at its best. Several of you made complimentary comments at the finish for which I am very grateful. My old friend Bob Cheesewright even said it was his best course for years - either he had a good run or he hasn't been competing much.

With this being a Silver Jubilee, I tried to make it a bit special, if only to honour those two gentlemen - Mike Johnson and Keith Parris - who created the first November Classic on this area in 1968. Interesting to note how orienteering styles have changed. I remember that in those days the Forestry Commission would only allowed us to run in the unenclosed land. We then looked longingly at the forest on the other side of the fence. This time I did all that I could to set courses in the natural forest where I felt the orienteering was better.

For the success of the event you have cause to be grateful to very many people, but from my perspective, I would like to thank three people (or groups) in particular;

- Colin Hicks and his mapping team - their names are on the maps. I always feel that the contribution that mappers make to the sport is undervalued and very few non-mappers realise just how much effort is involved. I would like to pay special thanks to Terry Sankey, who came in at a very late stage and quickly updated the Whiteshoot area of the Emery Down map; and also to Rod Postlethwaite (WRE), the mapping adviser, who did much to improve the clarity of the map, and certainly updated my somewhat ancient mapping style.

- Stirling Surveys did an excellent job controlling the map printing. They acted most professionally and helped very much by applying orienteering intelligence to the whole process.

- Bill Mansell, who assembled and directed an experienced SOC team with enthusiasm and expertise. Bill was responsible for all the negotiations with Acres Down Farm - use of their site made planning easier, and contributed much to the flavour of the event. I am also most grateful to Jean and Lubor Velecky for all their hard work constructing the new set of controls - they worked well.

- David Lee (NGOC), the controller. It was always comforting to know that David was carefully observing and checking all aspects of the planning process. I appreciated his suggestions and comments, always positively made. I am sure there were times when David would have liked to have made more extensive suggestions, but time was lacking, and we both knew the danger of making last minute changes.

I followed the guidelines on course combinations and lengths very closely, but did make two small adjustments:

- I planned two slightly different very junior courses (1 for W10, W11B, W13B; 2 for M10, M11B, M13B; 2 about .2k longer than 1) because I felt that the requirements of six classes were too wide to cover on a single course. I was

pleased with this decision, as some of the junior times were long. This didn't surprise me, because I felt that the courses were perhaps a little more difficult than those often offered. In this regard I would quote from the planning guidelines:

'Courses provided at National Events should always encourage entrants to run in their proper class.'
'National Event courses should be planned to test the orienteering ability of their leading competitors in each class.'

2. For the three TD=5, PD=2 courses I decided to set a short course for W60S only, thinking that there would be 'hidden' W65S and W70S entries as well. I was wrong, there were only two entrants on course 9. This bad decision may have caused the W45S and W65L courses to be longer than usual. If this is true Ladies, I apologise for selling you long.

All the courses were based on an effective length of 19.8k for the M21E to provide a winning time of 95 minutes. From the few results I've seen, the winning time is about 89 minutes. They're getting very fast these M21Es. As an ageing M50 I find it quite difficult to plan a real M21E course; I don't have an M21 brain any more.

Finally, a brief pass through the courses:

- Courses 1,2,3,4 were all very similar, a short excursion around the Acres Down plateau, staying on or near the well defined paths, with longer extensions southwards to provide the extra length.
- Courses 5,6,7 were southern loops almost to Millyford Bridge road (middle of the Emery Down map), extensions eastwards onto St. James's Hill, keeping clear of the larger marshes.
- Course 8 (M15A, M19B), always a difficult course to plan for me (TD=4, PD=4), length without real difficulty. This was the first course to go south of the Millyford Bridge road, into White Shoot. Some of the controls on this course may have been too difficult.
- Courses 9,10,11 were loops of increasing size around the plateau, using good point features in comfortable forest where possible.
- Courses 12,13,14,15 (TD=5, PD=3). Some quite good courses here I think, they fitted onto the small map well (only course 12 did not cross the road) and all had at least two controls in the intricate St. James's Hill area.
- Course 16, the longest (8.3k) course only on the small map, and possibly the most satisfactory. Lots of changes of direction and three longish legs.
- Courses 17,18. Awkward to plan, because they needed a short loop north from the start (about 3k) to provide the length. I tried to balance the dead running on the loop south through the enclosure corner with the choicest controls on the way north. Not the most satisfactory, but they did have a large number of long legs.
- Courses 19,20,21 were all very similar, first a loop north with a return through the enclosure. Sorry about the dead run to the collecting control 441. At least the good forest was still to come. All 6 longest courses had a leg of at least 1.3k going SSE after 441 at the exit from the enclosure, then a mixed leg-length run increasingly through the physical parts of the open forest.
- Courses 22,23,24. Similar in structure to the previous three courses, but with lengthening loops to the north then west from the start. (Only course 24 reached the west edge of the northern open area.) Increasingly contorted and longer loops on the small map gave all these courses many controls in the intricate St. James's Hill area. As an experiment I really tried to minimize the number of controls for the M21L (course 23, 19 controls, 13.2k). I'd be interested to know if this course was a success.

CONTROLLER'S COMMENTS - DAVID LEE

As 15:08 has passed on Sunday 1st November 1992, I feel that I can write the report. The map was clear but, as is typical of the New Forest, there were many clearings which grew or reduced, paths which changed by the day, trees which became brushings and marshes. However careful route choice and judicious (one might say 'fortunate') use of map detail enabled some to go round at high speed. It is a pleasure to see so many reporting to the finish with the

deep feeling that they had enjoyed their time in the forest. That is due to the Planner - the approach of Ray was first class. He tried to provide you with a challenge. It was a pleasure to work with him.

At times the event resembled the ugly duckling but I trust that the final result was a swan - albeit in need of its waterproofing.

Concern was expressed about the first control on courses 22, 23, and 24. It was on a spur and there was an amount of undergrowth which rendered the control difficult. I apologise to those whose run was affected by this control and congratulate those who found it rapidly. My gratitude to those who came and discussed their concerns in a constructive, helpful manner. I believe controlling is a learning experience. Thank you for teaching me so much. As ever, it is a pleasure to work with SOC and be so well organised by Bill.
