PLANNER'S REPORT

When I originally agreed to plan the 1993 November Classic on Highland Water, I expected to work with a co-planner for the longer Senior courses; as a heavyweight M55, courses longer than around 7 km are a bit outside my usual experience. However, after losing first one co-planner, then a second, then one co-controller, then the

other (How would Oscar Wilde have described this level of carelessness?), I finished up planning all 18 courses! The good news was that John Warren was able to step in to complete the good work started by Mike and Cris Tween the original Controllers.

I set out to give as many competitors as possible the opportunity to experience the very different challenges presented by the 3 main areas of the map, which included at John's suggestion, all but the very shortest courses having at least a brief excursion into the Northern open area. From comments heard and reported it seems that for most people I managed to produce courses that were both challenging and enjoyable. I was pleased to see from the results that most Badge times are within BOF guidelines and I was particularly gratified at the low level of retirement and disqualification, especially amongst the Juniors.

On the day it was fascinating to stand on the edge of the Northern open area and watch competitors emerge from the Inclosure with its complex network of mapped, unmapped and obscured paths, and immediately have to change their technique when faced with a totally different landscape. Yes, I know some of the marshes had turned a bit unpleasant due to the heavy rainfall a few weeks ago but a visit to the New Forest in November cannot be complete without wet feet and the brown stains do eventually wear off.

This was my first experience of the CONDES software which I can recommend to any planners who have not yet met it; in addition to its main functions of drawing the pictorial symbols and keeping track of changes to courses as the planning and controlling proceeds, it enabled me, by the analysis of course and competitor loadings on controls to rationalise the number of controls down to only 82. Incidentally, despite this relatively small number of controls for an event attracting over 1000 competitors, none of the sites (apart from the common last control) received excessive traffic. It also allowed my excellent forest team to put out and collect in the flags and punches in record time.

Apart from echoing the thanks of the Organiser to all those who made the 93 Classic a great success I have to add my own special thanks to John Warren for his tremendous support, encouragement and advice, those 18 courses were very much ours and not just mine.
