Planner's Comments

I hope you all enjoyed the event. We enjoyed planning on what is definitely amongst the best terrain we have in the New Forest. Very few events take place without problems, and this was no exception. Course 4 caused us problems even before the event took place, with a control missing in the course description list sent with the final details and printed on the map. The course description list had to be printed again and stuck on the maps, thanks to Bill Davidson and the map bagging team. To continue its jinxed life course 4 had control 11 (412) digitised in the wrong place over the shallow depression (413). This was discovered during the event and the Gaz adjudicated that anyone on course 4 punching control 11 at 413 should not be disqualified. Thanks Gary for that, and all the work you put in, looking at and agreeing our courses and your help on the day. In particular Gaz's speedy drive along Hampton Ridge to control 388, which had been vandalised in a 15 minute window of opportunity, between checking and the first SOC competitor arriving, averted a much bigger problem. Thanks to Jill Holt for promptly reporting it. Thankfully SportIdent's program allows a replacement unit to be incorporated during the event, thus minimising manual re-instatement of competitors.

We would like to put on record our thanks to the forest team, who put out controls on Saturday in beautiful weather, checked them early on Sunday morning, patrolled them during the event in reasonable weather, and were then faced with bringing them back in during a most violent storm, when most of us got soaked to the skin. I find it annoying to say the least that a control can still go missing with all the effort we put in, all we can do is to apologise to those affected and we hope it did not detract from your enjoyment of the event. The winning times seem to mostly conform to BOF guidelines, with some a little on the long side, but planning has to be based on the top competitors in each class, regardless of them competing.

However, for myself (Colin Hicks) my abiding memory of the event was witnessing Gaz running down the re-entrant at speed towards the site of control 388 brandishing a replacement SportIdent unit and stand and shouting his arrival to half a dozen confused competitors and them punching the unit before Gary barely had a chance to fix it into the ground! I just wished I had my camera.

Controller's Comments

I always regret offering to control an event that turns out to be in a really nice piece of terrain and is well favoured on the day. This year's Classic proved to be just so!

I haven't actually orienteered in the New Forest for some years as other commitments (normally the New York City Marathon) have taken first place. But this year offered my help and am really pleased despite the downpour later in the day.

The courses on the whole were fair and from the comments of the competitors at the finish were a challenge.

The slight overprint error on course 4 affected a few; I felt it fair to deem them competitive.

The vandalism of another control affected a few again and we have credited them with a complete run too.

As to using SportIdent, I have very mixed views. It certainly favours competitors with the ability to provide them with splits at the finish but the headache it causes the organisers is a very large negative. I'm no Luddite but somehow feel this is technology for technologies sake. (Almost like the statement "One day all shopping will be done on the internet!!") One slight glitch and the whole thing collapses. A stolen "station" is a costly thing and damp conditions put all electronic backup systems in jeopardy too. All organisers must have some manual backup.

This is particularly crucial to enable organiser and controller to assess who is still out in the forest as the event winds down. A stub checking system is simple but very efficient!

Bill and Colin were a joy to work with and the SOC club spirit was a credit too. Here's to next year's event in which I hope to be a competitor.
